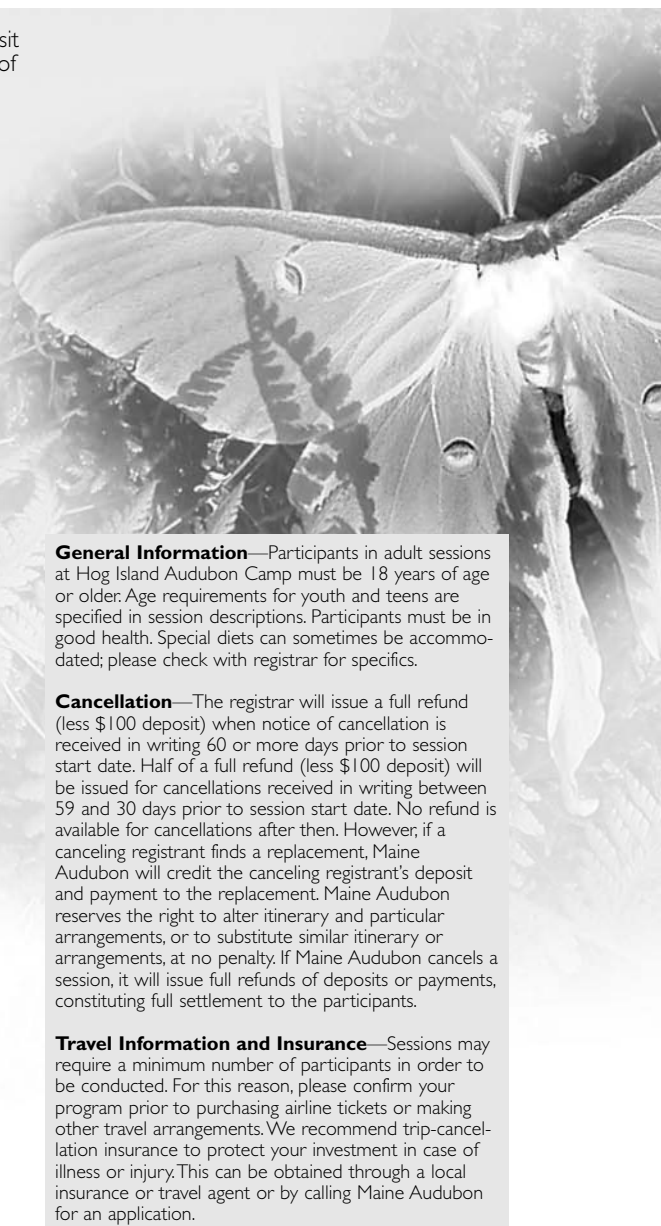

**General Information**—Participants in adult sessions at Hog Island Audubon Camp must be 18 years of age or older. Age requirements for youth and teens are specified in session descriptions. Participants must be in good health. Special diets can sometimes be accommodated; please check with registrar for specifics.

**Cancellation**—The registrar will issue a full refund (less \$100 deposit) when notice of cancellation is received in writing 60 or more days prior to session start date. Half of a full refund (less \$100 deposit) will be issued for cancellations received in writing between 59 and 30 days prior to session start date. No refund is available for cancellations after then. However, if a canceling registrant finds a replacement, Maine Audubon will credit the canceling registrant's deposit and payment to the replacement. Maine Audubon reserves the right to alter itinerary and particular arrangements, or to substitute similar itinerary or arrangements, at no penalty. If Maine Audubon cancels a session, it will issue full refunds of deposits or payments, constituting full settlement to the participants.

**Travel Information and Insurance**—Sessions may require a minimum number of participants in order to be conducted. For this reason, please confirm your program prior to purchasing airline tickets or making other travel arrangements. We recommend trip-cancellation insurance to protect your investment in case of illness or injury. This can be obtained through a local insurance or travel agent or by calling Maine Audubon for an application.
