No camping or overnight use/parking

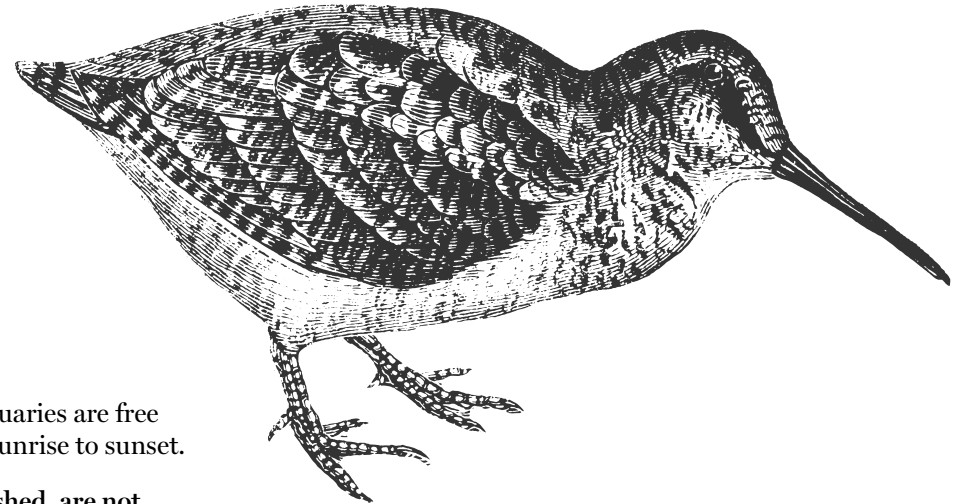
